

Boscobel Utilities / WPPI Energy **Public Power Scholarship**

\$1,500 Public Power Scholarship

Eligibility guidelines

1. High school seniors may submit an essay to win a scholarship. A total of \$1,500 is available for applicants. Up to three recipients may receive a scholarship with the minimum scholarship being \$500 and the maximum being \$1,500 if only one applicant is selected to receive a scholarship. The student (or their parent or legal guardian) must be a customer of Boscobel Utilities and reside in the Boscobel Area School District. ****Dependents of utility personnel are not eligible.****
2. High school senior must plan to attend a two-year technical college or a four-year university.
3. Essays should be on the theme: ***The value of Boscobel Utilities commitment to energy conservation, efficiency and renewable energy through its partnership with Focus on Energy.*** Essays should be between 500 and 1,000 words —typed and double-spaced — and include the following information on a cover sheet:
 - Student's first and last name Home address Phone number
 - Name of parent or legal guardian
 - Utility account information (Name on account; billing address; account number)
4. Deadline for submitting essays is April 28, 2017. Please submit all essays and the required information to:
